In accordance with Association policy, regular communication will be provided to NLTA members by way of periodic updates on the status of the collective bargaining process.

As communicated in the last Bargaining Brief on February 21, 2017, the exchange of opening proposals between the NLTA and government negotiating teams did not take place on the dates that had been previously scheduled (February 13-14). The meetings were postponed at government's request, but did not proceed due to the closure of NLTA and government offices for extreme weather conditions. New dates were recently confirmed and the exchange of opening proposals is scheduled to take place on March 30-31.

As per Association policy, the opening packages will be prepared and provided to members at Branch meetings following a session of Joint Council, which is scheduled to take place on Friday, April 21, immediately following the conclusion of the NLTA Biennial General Meeting. The dates of Branch meetings will be communicated in due course.

We will keep you advised of any significant developments or progress in negotiations through subsequent Bargaining Briefs and other communications as necessary.
