## Association Priorities 1999-2000

A planning/discussion session took place re: priorities for the 1999-2000 school year. The following are the four main priorities as determined by the Provincial Executive Council:



- classroom issues
- curriculum issues
- membership involvement
- collective bargaining preparations

## Ministerial Panel

The Ministerial Panel on the Delivery of Education in the Classroom met with Provincial Executive in Lewisporte to brief them on the focus of the panel. The terms of reference for the panel are:

1. Examine current educational delivery model and consider alternate approaches.
2. Conduct consultation to ascertain views on appropriate methods for allocating teacher resources and supporting the delivery of education in the classroom.
3. Examine current research, allocation procedures used in other jurisdictions, and methods of delivery.
4. Recommend changes to program offerings and current method of allocating teachers, program delivery methods and issues associated with teacher training and professional development.
