LABRADOR WEST TEACHERS REACH TENTATIVE AGREEMENT

St. John's NL...The Newfoundland and Labrador Teachers' Association has reached a tentative agreement with Government and the School Boards on a new collective agreement for teachers in Labrador West (Labrador City and Wabush). The Labrador West teachers are a separate bargaining unit under the Teachers' Collective Bargaining Act.

"The NLTA is pleased that our colleagues in Labrador West were able to reach a fair and reasonable collective agreement with the employer," says James Dinn, President of the Newfoundland and Labrador Teachers' Association. "We look forward to the results of the ratification of the Labrador West Collective Agreement."

The NLTA Provincial Executive has approved the holding of a ratification vote on the Labrador West tentative agreement, which will take place during the week of November 10-14, 2014. Further information regarding the tentative agreement will not be released until the details have been presented to teachers in Labrador West, which is planned for the week of November 3-7, 2014.
